FANNING THE FLAMES

How to Wait on God by Sarah Leonard

What do you do when you're waiting on God? Many people believe waiting for God means doing nothing. Psalm 27 describes how David "waited" on the Lord. He sums up his whole attitude towards waiting on God by saying in vs. 14, "Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage." (AMPC) How should a believer react to chaos? I know that my reaction is to spend more time seeking God, growing in faith, so I am ready to face anything that may come. My mom's reaction is intercessory prayer: she desires to pray that all of the injustices to be made

right. Which is right? They both are.

We should remain confident in God when the world around us is in chaos. In Psalm 27:1-3, David says that even if all of his enemies came against him with armies, he wouldn't fear because God was his salvation. God is your salvation too. Remain in a state of confident, steadfast, unmoved, unshaken faith in God.

We should earnestly seek after the Lord, desiring to "meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple" as David said in vs. 4-5. Then, as we visit with God in this intimate way, he promises to hide us in his shelter

and set us on a rock.

We should be crying out to God with an attitude of intercession. In vs. 7-9 and 12, David called to the Lord for help. He required that God show him mercy without doubt that God would hear and answer his prayers. When we intercede for our families, our friends, the nation, or anything else, we pray in confidence that God is faithful to hear and answer our prayers.

We should ask the Lord what to do. When faced with a decision, asking God which path we should take should be our first action instead of a last resort. In vs. 11, David said, "teach me your way, Lord" because he knew that God's way is the best way.

Finally, we should praise the Lord! All through Psalm 27, David stops to praise the Lord. Vs. 1, 6, 10, and 13 are all moments he stopped and praised. Praise keeps the focus off of the problem and puts it back on how big God is. It helps us to stay in the right attitude of waiting, hoping, and expecting God.

"Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage and let your heart be stout and enduring. Yes, wait for and hope for and expect the Lord."

Psalm 27:14 ampc
